Glossary of terms

WATHIFAH: special prayer (dhikr) performed between A'sr

and Maghrib prayer in congregation, out loud

ISTIGHFAR: saying "astaghfiru Allah"

SALAWAAT: sending salutations to Prophet Muhammad,

peace and blessings of Allah be upon him

HAYLALA: the special Friday dhikr

TAHLEEL: to say "la ilaaha illa Allah"

WATHIFAH

It consists of four (4) recitals and must be performed once during the day. However, it is recommended by Elhadji Malick Sy to practice it twice (2) a day.

The recitals are:

- THE ISTIGHFAR (asking forgiveness from GOD our Lord) the best is to do it in the formula of ASTAGHFIRU ALLAHAL ATHEEMA ALLATHEE LA ILAHA ILLA HOUWAL HAYYUL QAYYUM (30 times)
- Pray on the Prophet (50 times) Here it is obligatory that this prayer be Salat al Fatih. ALLAHUMA SAL I'ALA SAYYIDINA MUHAMADIL FATIHI LIMA 'UGHLIQ WAL KHATIM LIMA SABAQA NASIRIL HAQQI BIL HAQQI WAL HADI ILAA SIRATIKAL MUSTAQEEM WA'ALA ALIHI, HAQQA QADRIHI WA MIODARIHIL ATHEEM



- 3. The evocation of the name of ALLAH, say "LA ILAHA ILLA ALLAH" (100 TIMES).
- 4. Recite JAWHARAT AL KAMAL (12 times)

"O Allah, send benediction upon and salute on the Essence of Divine Mercy, the Accomplished Ruby encompassing the center of comprehensions and meanings, the Light of all created universes, the Adamic who possesses Lordly Truth; the all-filling Lightning in the rain-clouds of gains that fill all the intervening seas and receptacles; Your Bright Light with which You have filled Your creation and which surrounds all possible places. O Allah, bless and salute the Essence of Truth from which are manifested the thrones of realities, the Essence of the Most Righteous Knowledge, Your Complete and Most Straight Path. O Allah, bless and salute the Advent of the Truth by the Truth; the Greatest Treasure, Your Outpouring from Yourself to Yourself; the Encompassment of Talismanic Light. May Allah bless the Prophet and his household, a prayer which brings us to knowledge of him."

THE HAYLALA (THE HADRA OF FRIDAY, THE 'ASRU)

The Haylala (other names: Hadra, 'Asru) is the Friday dhikr, which is performed between 'Asr and Maghreb Prayers.

Like the Wadhifa, the Friday Hadra must be performed in congregation whenever it is possible, arranging the ranks properly, reciting loud. If there is no congregation to join, do it alone. It is performed only on Friday, between 'Asr and Maghreb Prayers, the best time is just before the Azan of the Maghreb Prayer. If not accomplished during this time period, we can't make up for it. The Haylala is composed of one single element: Recitation of 1000 or 1200 or 1600 times "La llaha illa Allah"



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
